



Internal Call – BLUE-LINK Network No. 04/2026

Visiting Professor Fellowship in Brazil

2027-1 Schedule

The Office of Research and Graduate Studies (PROPESP) of the Federal University of Rio Grande (FURG), in the exercise of its responsibilities, hereby announces this Internal Call in compliance with the provisions of [BLUE-LINK Network Call No. 4/2026](#). This Internal Call aims to qualify candidates for the allocation of Visiting Professor Fellowships in Brazil, to perform activities within FURG Graduate Programs participating in the BLUE-LINK Network of the CAPES Global.edu Program (<https://capesglobal.furg.br/>).

1. GENERAL CONDITIONS

1.1 This Internal Call follows the regulations established in [BLUE-LINK Network Call No. 4/2026](#) and publicizes the selection process for the allocation of Visiting Professor Fellowships in Brazil within FURG Graduate Programs participating in the BLUE-LINK Network. The list of Graduate Programs participating in each Network Theme may be consulted on the Network website under the tab dedicated to each Theme (<https://capesglobal.furg.br/>).

1.2 The requirements and responsibilities of the parties involved, as well as the list of mandatory application documents, must strictly comply with the provisions of [BLUE-LINK Network Call No. 4/2026](#).

1.3 The ranking of candidates and the allocation of fellowships shall be carried out by a selection committee specifically appointed for this purpose by the Office of Research and Graduate Studies (PROPESP), composed of faculty members nominated by the Graduate Programs.

1.4 A candidate's qualification by FURG does not guarantee the award of a fellowship. Validation of the final results of the BLUE-LINK Network is the responsibility of its Steering Committee, which will verify compliance with all regulations established in [BLUE-LINK Network Call No. 4/2026](#).

2. NUMBER OF FELLOWSHIPS

2.1 Number of available fellowships, each lasting fifteen (15) days, by BLUE-LINK Network Theme and participating Graduate Programs:



I – Biodiversity and Biotechnology for the Blue Economy and Its Management: 1 (one) fellowship. Participating Graduate Programs: Environmetrics, Biology of Continental Aquatic Environments, Applied Economics, Food Engineering and Science, Biological Oceanography, Oceanology;

II – Climate Change, Extreme Events, and Their Socio-Environmental Impacts on Estuarine, Coastal, and Oceanic Ecosystems: 2 (two) fellowships. Participating Graduate Programs: Aquaculture, Biology of Continental Aquatic Environments, Physiological Sciences Computer Science, Environmental Education, Geography, Oceanology;

III – Human Health in the Context of One Health in Estuarine and Coastal Regions: 2 (two) fellowships. Participating Graduate Programs: Health Sciences, Physiological Sciences, Computer Engineering, Nursing, Psychology, Technological and Environmental Chemistry, Public Health;

IV – Food Security and Quality from Estuarine, Coastal, and Oceanic Natural Resources: 1 (one) fellowship. Participating Graduate Programs: Aquaculture, Food Engineering and Science, Biological Oceanography, Technological and Environmental Chemistry, Agroindustrial Systems and Processes.

2.2 Applications must be restricted to themes in which the Graduate Program participates.

2.3 Transfer of fellowships between themes is not permitted.

2.4 According to the CAPES schedule, fellowships must commence, without exception, on the first day of the months from March through June 2027.

3. APPLICATIONS

3.1 Applications must be submitted by the coordinator of the interested Graduate Program, following internal arrangements with the candidate, according to the schedule established in this Internal Call, by sending all documentation required under BLUE-LINK Network Call No. 4/2026 to diposg.direcao@furg.br with the subject line “Inscrição Chamada Interna 4/2026 – PV”.

3.2 All requirements and documents listed in [BLUE-LINK Network Call No. 4/2026](#) constitute mandatory eligibility conditions for candidature.

4. SELECTION PROCESS AND EVALUATION CRITERIA



4.1 The selection process shall strictly follow the criteria established [BLUE-LINK Network Call No. 4/2026](#).

4.2 The selection committee specifically appointed for this Internal Call shall be responsible for all stages of the internal selection process, including the evaluation and publication of all results.

4.3 Approved candidates who are not awarded fellowships by FURG shall remain in the general BLUE-LINK Network competition as alternates and may receive fellowships not utilized by other institutions, in accordance with Section 7.4 of [BLUE-LINK Network Call No. 4/2026](#), while observing the provisions of Section 2.3 of this Internal Call.

5. APPEALS

5.1 Appeals against the results of the selection process must be submitted by the Graduate Program Coordination through which the application originated.

5.2 Only appeals sent to diposg.direcao@furg.br, within the deadlines established in the schedule will be considered.
